Current legislation concerning the right to privacy and the publication of video/photographic material on the web. Law 633/1941 (Protection of copyright and other rights related to its exercise). Art. 96 A portrait of a person may not be exhibited, reproduced or put on the market without the consent of that person [...] or the legal guardian. Civil Code - Art. 10 (Abuse of another person's image). If the image of a person or of his parents, spouse or children has been exhibited or published outside the cases in which such exhibition or publication is permitted by law, or with prejudice to the decorum or reputation of that person or of said relatives, the judicial authority, at the request of the person concerned, may order that the abuse cease, subject to compensation for damages. Civil Code - Art. 316 (Exercise of parental authority). The child is subject to parental authority until the age of majority or emancipation. Parental authority is exercised by mutual agreement by both parents. Legislative Decree 196/03 - Art. 23 (Consent). The processing of personal data by private individuals or public economic entities is only permitted with the express consent of the person concerned. Consent is validly given only if it is freely and specifically expressed with reference to a clearly identified processing operation and if it is documented in writing. Consent shall be given in writing when the processing concerns sensitive data.
